



## **Kirkland Academy for Excellence – Labor of Love Day Camp 2019** **(KAE-LOL Day Camp 2019)**

### **Overview**

The **Kirkland Academy for Excellence – Labor of Love Day Camp (KAE-LOL Day Camp)** will operate Monday through Friday from July 8-19, 2019. The two-one week day camp sessions will operate from 7:30 am until 4:30 pm. The day camp will serve elementary school students who will be in Kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> Grade in September 2019. The KAE-LOL Summer Day Camp, designed around two themes, will offer academic instruction in the morning and enrichment activities in the afternoon. There are also two (2) planned field trips to sites that will be both educational and designed to increase the cultural capital of the participating students. The KAE-LOL Summer Day Camp will provide small group instruction organized around grade levels. The academic focus includes related reading and writing instruction with a special focus on STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics) activities.

### **Weekly Themes**

Each week will focus on one thematic unit.



1. **“The Tiny World of Atoms and Microscopes”** will give students a chance to explore the Periodic Chart of elements, design a model of an element and learn to use a microscope. The week will also include fun-filled afternoon activities including a Wakanda Afternoon and an Olympic Day at Ted Watkins Park. The field trip for the first week is pending.



2. **“Exploring the Barrier Reef”** will give students an opportunity to explore the structure and animals that live in around the Barrier Reef of Australia. They will learn about the various types of coral and how coral supports marine life in an around Australia. The field trip will take the students to the Aquarium of the Pacific to see coral up close and personal! The students will also take a boat tour of the Long Beach Harbor.
